Little Free Library at Lake Raconda

It looks like a tiny covered bridge full of books. Anyone can take a book, keep it, return it, or pass it on to someone else. Anyone can drop off a book someone else might want to read. Readers are encouraged to share their comments about a book with other readers. Books flow in from friends and neighbors and out to new friends and neighbors.

Alan Baker built this library out of plywood, scrap lumber, and an old mirror from Twice Blessed. He hopes it will be a way for members of the community to share with each other. It's on Lake Raconda Road at Stearns Avenue in Wilmington. You can even pick up a book to read while you're at the Green Mountain Beach.

The Little Free Library movement began in Wisconsin in 2009. There are thousands of Little Free Libraries across the country, five in Vermont, and this is the first in Windham County.
